ESG: Myth or reality?


Doing business based on environmental, social and governance (ESG) criteria has now spread worldwide, but ESG can mean different things to different people. This has created scepticism and even raised the notion that it could be nothing more than a marketing strategy. Despite consensus on the importance of ESG values in business, the lack of specific regulation can affect the commitment of investors to apply them.

Latin America is not alien to this discussion, having in many cases followed the experience of multinational companies and international rating organisations to standardise the collection and reporting of ESG's impact. This session will analyse the criticism of ESG, the impact of ESG values in Latin America and the influence of international regulations, particularly European rules. We will discuss the trends in ESG in the future and the goals and challenges facing them.

Breakout session 4

The compliance boom

This session will explore the dynamic and high-stakes world of compliance in Latin America. The companies and individuals who operate in the region face ongoing scrutiny and pressure from traditional outsiders (eg, the US Department of Justice (DOJ), the US Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), European prosecutors, etc) and the application of their toolset to doing business in the region. However, trends are emerging with regards to local authorities becoming increasingly vigilant, the market being much more sensitive to compliance issues and harsh penalties being introduced and regularly enforced. The pressure to adhere to high standards is consequently mounting. Navigating the booming compliance landscape in Latin America requires high levels of concentration and dynamic counsel, as it often involves untested regulations, ambiguity and unknown risks. This session will delve into these issues and help you navigate this exciting but uncharted territory.

Sustainable finance

This session will explore the growing role of sustainable finance in Latin America as a tool to achieve the sustainability development goals (SDGs), focusing on the challenges and opportunities it presents for both public and private sectors in emerging markets. We will discuss the evolving regulatory landscape, the innovative financial instruments aimed at promoting ESG (green and social bonds, sustainability-linked bonds, etc.), the participation of traditional financial institutions in the sustainable finance market, the impact of international standards on local markets, the importance of a common taxonomy, regulatory and market incentives, and the relevance of disclosure practices. The discussion will address how Latin America is designing strategies to achieve the SDGs, the role of lenders, investors, and companies in driving change, and the prospects of sustainable finance.

Class actions Latin-style

In civil law countries the judicial system has traditionally been designed to protect individual rights. However, certain collective rights have garnered protection in Latin America and the rise of consumer associations and the influence from other jurisdictions have increased the cases and importance of class actions for market participants.

Yet more than 20 years after the Model Code of Collective Proceedings for Ibero-America 2004, the progress of class actions has been inconsistent across Latin America, both in legislation and in judicial decisions.

This session will present a practical overview of the issues related to class actions in Latin America, highlighting the key areas – such as antitrust – where this protective mechanism has evolved and discussing the ongoing challenges in balancing collective access to justice and defence rights.
